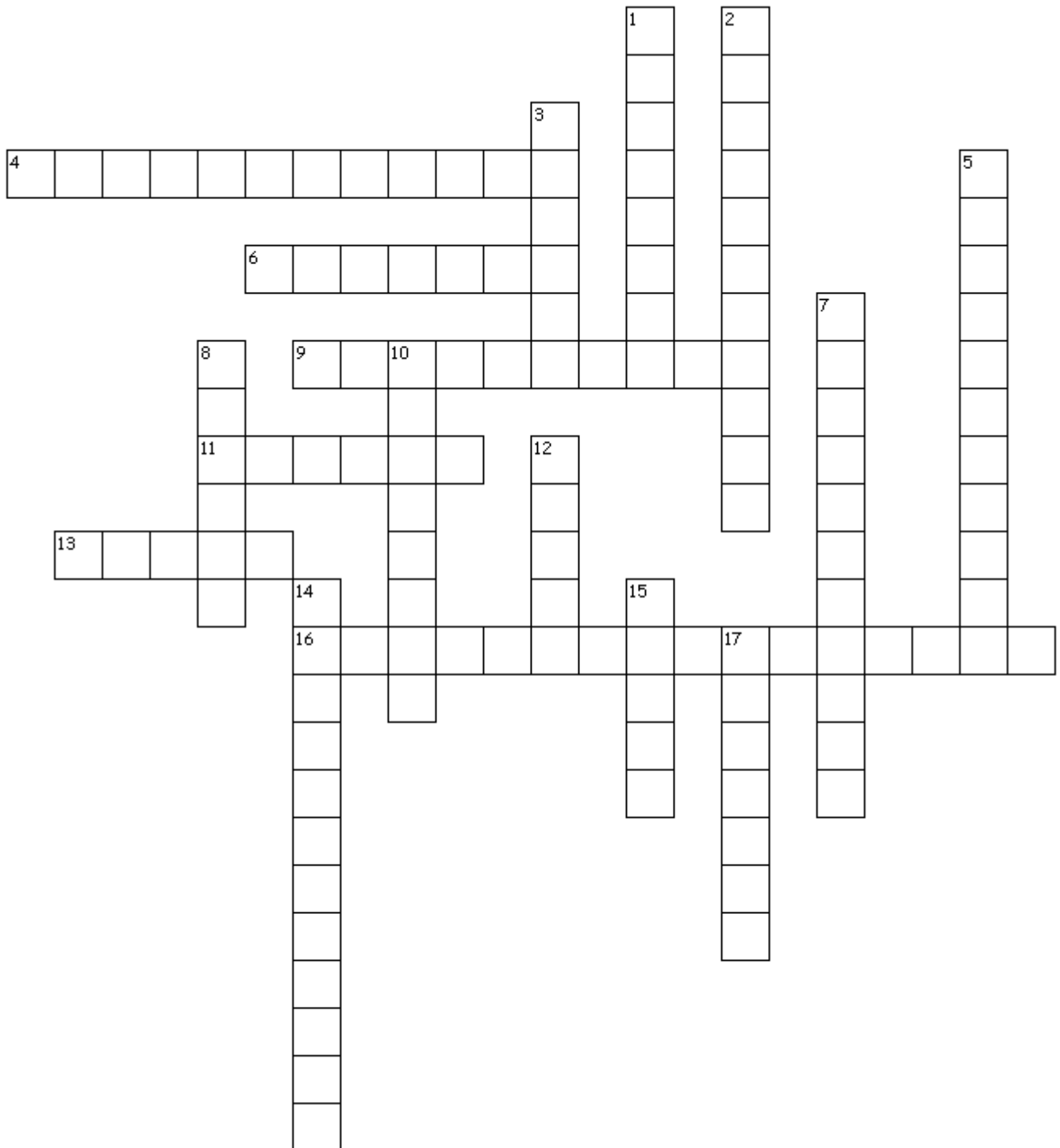


A Living Tradition Crossword
